CARE

For routine cleaning to remove dust, use a soft, dry cloth. If stains occur, blot them immediately with a dry cloth or paper towel. To remove any marks, use a cloth slightly dampened with water, then dry thoroughly. Clean gently to avoid scratching the surfaces. Over time, the color of the burnished finish may fade or become dull, especially if the surfaces are exposed to direct sunlight.

CAUTION

Avoid using abrasive sponges and harsh cleaning products containing alcohol, acetone, ammonia, chlorine, or solvents, as they may irreversibly stain or corrode the surfaces. Be careful with weak acids found in food (such as tomatoes or lemons), which could cause surface damage if not removed promptly.

DAMAGE TO THE COATING

The protective coating is more susceptible to accidental scratches: take the utmost care to avoid contact with sharp or pointed objects such as rings, buckles, studs, keys, buttons, or tableware. Differences from the sample photo of the supplied product or between the various materials used are not to be considered a manufacturing defect, but rather a characteristic of the handcrafted and artistic process, which may be subject to color variations.
