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Care and Maintenance Instructions

Wilsonart Laminate: To clean the surface, use a damp cloth or sponge and a mild soap or detergent. Rinse thoroughly with warm water and wipe dry. Please reference Wilsonart Laminate Care and Maintenance for other instructions:

Care and Cleaning of Wood: Finished wood surfaces should be cleaned with a soft damp cloth, wiping in the direction of the grain. Furniture should be buffed dry immediately with a soft cloth.

Corian Care and Maintenance: To clean Corian or solid surfaces, use a damp microfiber cloth to clean most spills. For most residues, use microfiber cloth and warm soapy water or a dedicated Corian countertop cleaner. (Do not use window cleaners.) Rinse and dry in circular motions.

Care and Maintenance of Steel and Metal: Cleaning of stainless steel, chrome and other metals should be done routinely with appropriate soft (non-abrasive) cloth and clean, warm water with or without a gentle detergent. Always wipe with the directional grain of the steel, not across it. Dry completely with a soft dry cloth.

FENIX Care and Maintenance: Fenix is an opaque and anti-fingerprint surface. It is **water-repellent, hygienic** and resistant to mold. No special maintenance is required. Just a damp cloth with warm water or a mild detergent and wipe it down.

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Cleaning and Disinfecting

The following guidelines are provided as general cleaning and disinfecting practices for use on furniture finishes.

Special safeguards should be given to finishes with heavy, open grain, carvings or crevasses, where the cleaner/disinfectant can easily puddle up and quickly cause deterioration of the finish.

STEP 1: Pre-mix Solution - Fill a spray bottle with 2 cups of water and 1 cup of white vinegar, then add approximately 5 drops of mild, liquid dish soap to the solution and mix well.

STEP 2: Spray the solution on the wood furniture and wipe off immediately using a soft, water dampened cloth, wiping in the direction of the grain. The dampened cloth will help remove traces of the vinegar and soap. Continue across the finished furniture until the piece is cleaned and disinfected. Immediately, proceed to STEP 3.

STEP 3: Immediately following STEP 2, wipe over the entire surface of the furniture in the direction of the grain using a soft, dry cleaning cloth to remove any excess moisture. Pay special attention to finishes with open grain, ensuring that all traces of the cleaning solution have been properly removed.

It is very important to note that excessive cleaning may, over time, result in the deterioration of the protective coating film. We would recommend a micro- fiber cloth when applying these products to prevent excessive scratching.

Maintain regular dustings with a non-wax furniture polish between cleanings. This will help keep the surface free of dust that can scratch the finish during regular cleanings.
