
OUR GOALS

Next Level Production

Designed with product life cycle in mind, Knoll's Life chair is taking production to a whole new level. Life uses minimal materials, features high recycled and recyclable content, and has easily replaceable components.

Waste Reduction

We are setting new standards and working toward zero hazardous waste at all of our facilities. In the past 20 years, our Geiger facilities we have achieved an annual reduction in hazardous waste by 98% and volatile organic compounds (VOCs) by 96%.

Material Chemistry

We maintain a database of approximately 4,000 chemicals that have been eco-profiled and pay attention to what gets used in our products, our processes, and our facilities because safer materials is better for us all.

Wood Excellence

MillerKnoll is committed to purchasing materials that are responsibly sourced, including FSC (Forest Stewardship Council) certified products as a standard—without special request, additional charge, or extended lead times.
